In his role as a Municipal Advisor with the Ontario Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Ministry of Housing, he provides support to municipal staff, elected officials and residents on municipal legislation, programs and initiatives.

Spencer holds two BA (Hons.) degrees from Huron College – one in English Language and Literature, the other in Political Science. In 2013, Spencer received a Master of Public Administration from Western University's Local Government Program.
